- The co-operation and collaborations committee shall examine proposals received or initiated by the University to sign Memorandums of Understanding with any other University in India or abroad or authorities, including learned bodies or associations.

- The Co-operation and Collaborations Committee shall examine the proposals, taking into consideration all aspects involving rights and obligations of the University and shall make a recommendation as to whether it is in the interest of the University to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding.
- The recommendations of the Co-operation and Collaborations Committee together with the draft of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be placed for the consideration and approval of the Academic Council and Executive Council of the University.
- A Memorandum of Understanding shall be for a fixed period (to be decided by the University) and shall be reviewed periodically by the Co-operation and Collaborations Committee for continuation, extension or termination.
