PREAMBLE

Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University (RGNAU) has been set up by the virtue of RGNAU Act, 2013. The University has been set up for the objective of providing world class facilities in the country in order to train the manpower so as to excel in the field of aviation. The Executive Council (EC), as per the RGNAU Act, 2013, shall be the principal executive body of the University. As per the RGNAU first statute, EC shall have the power of management and administration of revenue and property of the University and the conduct of all administrative affairs of the University. Also, it has got the power to manage and regulate the finances, accounts, investments, property, business and all other administrative affairs of the University. Vice Chancellor, as per the RGNAU Act, 2013, shall be the principal executive and academic officer of the University and shall exercise general supervision and control over the affairs of the University.

- 2. Broadly, the University has got four main decision making powers viz. Executive Council, Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Head of the School / Dean. At this instance, since EC, RGNAU being the principal executive body of the University has to delegate its powers to the various decision making bodies / officers of RGNAU. The schedule indicating the Delegation of Powers to the officers of the University is sub-divided as under:
 - Schedule of administrative and financial powers delegated to Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Head of the Divisions/ Director of Schools / Deans
 - Schedule of HR and personnel powers delegated to Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Head of the Divisions / Director of Schools / Deans
- 3. The Powers delegated shall be exercised only by the authorities indicated and to the extent specified. Delegation of Powers specified has been made with due regard to the need of decentralisation and expeditious disposal of business at all levels. The powers mentioned herein should be viewed in their correct perspective and

exercised judiciously by the officers concerned. The exercise of the powers delegated is subject to observance of provisions of extant code rules and other orders. Due regard must be paid to the standards of Financial propriety, guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure, GFR, Manual of Procurement of Goods and Services, CVC guidelines and other relevant Government orders.

- 4. Except where otherwise indicated, financial sanctions, as distinguished from administrative, should be accorded only after obtaining prior concurrence of the Finance Division.
- 5. In the case of purchase of Stores/Materials, the powers delegated are only for administrative sanction and procurement is to be made only in the normal channel through Stores Department except purchases through imprest wherever authorised.
- 6. Powers of sanction in all cases are subject to availability of funds. The certification of availability of funds should, be brought out in each proposal for the information of the Finance Officer and the sanctioning authority.
- 7. In exercising the powers, the officers concerned should keep in view various instructions issued for observance of utmost economy in Government expenditure.
- 8. The detailed document indicating the Delegation of Powers to the officers of the University along with the references from RGNAU's Act and Statute is as appended.
