## REGULATIONS FOR AWARD OF MEDALS

The University shall identify the best graduate of each Department who shall be bestowed with the Gold Medal in appreciation of their academic achievement.

The University shall also identify the runner-up of each Department who shall be bestowed with the Silver Medal respectively in appreciation of their academic achievement.

There are 04 medals including gold and silver medal as follows

- i. President Gold Medal (Among all UG Programmes)- On Merit basis
- ii. Chancellor Gold Medal (Among all PG Programmes) Merit + Overall performance (Sports & Extracurricular activities)
- iii. Gold Medal (UG & PG) Highest Percentage/CGPA as the case may be in each programme
- iv. Silver Medal (UG & PG) Second Percentage/CGPA as the case may be in each programme

Best graduate of a Department shall be identified from the group of students who fulfil below mentioned points;

- 1. The student must have completed the program in which he/she took admission, i.e. he/she should have completed 06/08 semesters if admitted in Graduate program, 02/03 semesters if admitted in Post Graduate Diploma program, 4 semesters if admitted in the Post Graduate program and 10 semesters if admitted Integrated Master Degree programme. Students who opted for exit shall not be considered for any medal.
- 2. The student should not have any back paper at any time during his/her course of study in a program, in other words, the student must have cleared all the papers of all semesters in one go.
- 3. The student should have scored 1st Class or equivalent Grade Points in total.
- 4. The student should have good track record, i.e, there should not be any complaint, charge/inquiry pending or against him/her.
- 5. The student who has scored highest CGPA among all the students of the programme satisfying points 1 to 4 above shall be the best graduate of the programme and shall be bestowed with the gold medal.
- 6. Similarly, the student who has scored second highest CGPA among all the students of the programme satisfying points 1 to 4 above shall be the runner-up of the programme and shall be bestowed with the silver (Optional, depends upon University's decision on annual basis).

- 7. If there are more than one student identified for a medal, the same shall be bestowed jointly to all such identified students.
- 8. Further, if there are less than 5 students in a program, students from such a program shall not be considered for award of medals. In such case, merit shall be decided collectively amongst the students of the respective School.
- 09. The list of awardees for the gold medals shall be prepared by the Academic Evaluation Committee well in time to ensure presentation of the awards in the convocation.
- 10. These regulations shall apply to the medals instituted by the University as well as those donated by individuals, societies, institutions etc.
- 11. President Gold Medal is awarded to the best outgoing UG student who is adjudged to be the academically best, securing the highest Percentage/CGPA at the end of the Sixth/Eighth semester of 03/04 year UG course among the students of all UG programmes of the year.
- 12. Chancellor Gold Medal is awarded to the outgoing PG student who is adjudged to be the academically best, securing the highest Percentage/CGPA at the end of the Tenth semester for 5 Years Integrated Master Degree Programme or after the completion of fourth semester of 2 Years PG degree or after the completion of second/third semester of 01 Years/1 ½ year PG Diploma among the students of all courses and overall performance (on the basis of merit in studies, Sports & extracurricular activities).
