Scope of Work

Name of Work: Civil and Structural Works for Display of Trainer Aircraft at RGNAU, Academic Campus, Fursatganj, Amethi – 229302

The scope of work shall include the following activities:

- Site Preparation & Earth Work
 - o Carrying out surface excavation in all kinds of soil up to required depth and width for foundation works.
 - o Disposal of excavated earth within specified lead and lift, including dressing and leveling of site.
- Cement Concrete Work (Foundation/Base)
 - o Providing and laying cement concrete (1:2:4 mix) at required locations for foundation and support bases.
 - o Ensuring proper compaction, leveling, finishing, and curing as per CPWD specifications.
- Structural Steel Work
 - o Supply, fabrication, and erection of structural steel work in built-up sections, trusses, and frames.
 - o Cutting, welding, bolting, hoisting, and fixing in position as per requirement.
 - o Providing and applying a priming coat of approved steel primer on all structural members.
- Tubular Steel Framework
 - o Providing and fixing steel tubular sections (hot finished welded type tubes) .
 - o Fabrication, welding, and erection of tubular members including necessary fittings and fixtures.
- Holding Down Bolts & Base Fixing
 - o Providing and fixing mild steel holding down bolts with nuts and washer plates complete.
 - o Ensuring proper alignment, embedment, and anchorage of structural members.
- Chemical Anchoring & Grouting
 - o Providing and applying approved make chemical anchoring compound (Fischer or equivalent).
 - o Providing and filling non-shrink grout under base plates including surface preparation.
 - o Ensuring proper bonding and load transfer.
- Chain Support System
 - o Providing and welding hot-dip galvanized mild steel short link chains (8 mm thick).
 - o Fixing and securing chains
- Painting & Surface Protection
 - o Cleaning and preparation of steel surfaces prior to painting.
 - o Applying one coat of approved red oxide zinc chromate primer.
 - o Finishing with two or more coats of synthetic enamel paint of approved brand.
- Installation & Alignment
 - o Proper alignment and leveling of all structural components to ensure stability and safety.
 - o Ensuring adequate load-bearing capacity for long-term display of the aircraft.
- Quality & Safety
 - o All works to be executed as per latest CPWD specifications with up to date correction slips and standard engineering practices.
 - o Ensuring safety of workers, structure, and surrounding area during execution.
- Completion & Handover
 - o Cleaning of site and removal of debris after completion of work.
 - o Final inspection and handing over of the completed installation in ready-to-use condition to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. General Eligibility** This is an open tender. Bidders who are Indian citizens / Proprietorship / Partnership firms / Limited Liability Partnerships (LLPs) / Companies / Societies / Trusts registered under the relevant Indian laws and having a valid PAN and GST Registration in applicable category are eligible to participate.
- 2. Relaxation in Eligibility Criteria** Considering the small value of the work (₹1,16,718/- only) and to promote wider participation, transparency, competition, and efficiency, the following relaxations are being provided:
 - No minimum similar work experience is required.
 - No requirement of prior enlistment/registration with CPWD, PWD, MES, Railways, or any other Government Department/PSU.Bidders availing this relaxation shall submit a Self-Declaration in the prescribed format (Annexure-I) on their letterhead, confirming that:
 - They possess adequate financial capability, technical personnel, tools & equipment, and competence to execute the work satisfactorily.
 - They are not executing more than **one (01)** work under the relaxed eligibility criteria at present.
- 3. Mandatory Requirements** The following documents are mandatory for all bidders (including those availing relaxation):
 - Valid PAN Card of the firm/proprietor (self-attested copy).
 - Valid GST Registration Certificate (self-attested copy).
 - EMD of the prescribed amount (except for MSE bidders who submit valid MSE registration certificate covering the tendered nature of work).
 - Duly filled and signed Technical Bid Form.
 - Annual turnover Certified by CA (last three financial years to be enclosed, self-attested copies) of at least 50% of the estimated value of this tender or bank solvency certificate 40% of the estimated cost put to tender.
 - Annexure-I (Self Declaration for relaxation, if applicable).
 - Annexure-II (Declaration & Undertaking).
- 4. Optional Documents** (Submission not mandatory for qualification)
 - Work experience certificates of last 3 years (if available).
 - ITRs for the last 3 assessment years (if available).
 - Enlistment/Registration certificate with any Government body (if available).
 - List of clients (if available).
 - Non-submission of the above optional documents shall not be a ground for rejection of the bid, provided annexure-I claiming relaxation is duly filled.
- 5. Blacklisting / Debarment** The bidder should not have been blacklisted, debarred, or banned by any Central/State Government Department, Public Sector Undertaking, or Autonomous Body as on the date of submission of the bid. A declaration to this effect shall be submitted in Annexure-II.
- 6. Preference to Make in India** The bidder shall comply with the provisions of the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017 (as amended from time to time).
- 7. Bidders from Countries sharing Land Border with India** Any bidder from a country sharing a land border with India shall be eligible to bid only if registered with the competent authority as per the latest guidelines issued by the Government of India.
- 8. MSE Exemption** Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with the appropriate authority are exempted from payment of EMD, subject to submission of a valid and active MSE registration certificate covering the nature of work specified in the tender.

Terms & Conditions

1. The Bids should be submitted through Online CPP Portal only, and hard copy of EMD payment details must be submitted at Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University, Fursatganj, Amethi before the BID opening date:20.04.2026 or proof of payment of EMD shall be uploaded on CPP portal.
2. Bidders are required to upload the “Technical Bid” and “Financial Bid” separately at the designated place in the required format in CPP Portal.
3. The Technical Bid shall not include any financial information. Such a bid will be summarily rejected.
4. The Financial Bid shall also be uploaded online in the prescribed XLS format as per BOQ available in CPP Portal along with the bid.
5. Financial Proposal should contain the ‘Price Schedule’ in the prescribed XLS format. All prices should be in Indian Rupees.
6. The site visits shall be entirely at the bidder's own cost and expense.
7. The work shall be executed and accepted strictly as per CPWD Specifications and directions of the Engineer-in-Charge.
8. In case the work is left incomplete or abandoned at any stage for any reason, the remaining work shall be completed departmentally or through other contractor(s). The additional expenses incurred shall be borne by the original contractor and recovered from dues or through legal channels.
9. No tools and tackles shall be provided by the department.
10. Any damage caused to the existing building/structure during execution shall be restored by the contractor at their own cost.
11. The contractor shall be fully responsible for any mishap or accident at the site during execution of work.
12. Failure to commence or execute the work post award/agreement shall lead to forfeiture of the EMD without any prior notice.
13. Quantities shown in the BOQ are approximate and may vary up to 10% either side.
14. Sub-standard material and workmanship will be rejected without any compensation and no claim for any loss or damage thereof shall be entertained.
15. In case the bidder(s) submit a false certificate/certification w.r.t. the tender or any other statutory documents, his/her tender will be rejected summarily.
16. No sub-letting of the work is allowed.
17. No claim for any fluctuation in rates or otherwise shall be entertained.
18. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
19. No advance payment is admissible.
20. Payment will be made through RTGS/PFMS post satisfactory completion as per details provided by the bidder along with the Tender.
21. The bidder shall depute competent and qualified person/staff to supervise the work.
22. The rates quoted by the bidder shall be applicable for the entire period of the contract. No revision in rates will be allowed during the contract period.
23. The bidder shall be responsible for fulfilling all statutory provisions of all labour laws and also payment of wages as per Minimum Wages Act/Rules of the Union as well as State Government.
24. For this small-value work (₹1,16,718 only, 15-day duration), and to promote wider participation, transparency, competition and efficiency, the following are relaxed:
 - General construction experience, similar work experience and bid capacity.
 - Valid enlistment/registration with CPWD/PWD/MES/Railway/PSU or any other government bodyBidders availing the relaxation must:
Submit self-declaration (Annexure I) confirming adequate capability, personnel, equipment and competence.
Such bidders shall not hold more than **one (01)** works under relaxed conditions .
The University reserves the right to verify details and reject any unsuitable or non-responsive bid.
25. The bidder/agency shall be the sole employer of the staff deployed for the said work, and they shall not be entitled to any claim for employment or permanency of job with RGNAU, Fursatganj, Amethi.
26. Terms and conditions and can be modified, changed, or added in the interest of the Institute at the time of signing the Work Order within government guidelines.
27. Taxes and necessary deductions as applicable shall be deducted from the bill(s) raised by the executing agency.
28. The bidder shall comply with the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017 (as

- amended).
29. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with authorized agencies are exempted from submission of EMD, subject to submission of a valid registration certificate covering the tendered work. The certificate must be valid on the date of bid submission. Bids claiming EMD exemption without valid MSE certificate shall be treated as non-responsive.
 30. “Any bidder from a country sharing land border with India shall be eligible to bid only if registered with the competent authority as per Government of India guidelines.”
 31. All disputes shall be settled under Amethi jurisdiction only.
 32. Time allowed for completion of work shall be 15 days. The work shall be started within 5 days after issue of Work Award Letter.
 33. The price bid should include all taxes and charges, if any.
 34. “Submission of experience, turnover and ITR documents is **optional for bidders availing relaxation under Annexure-I** and shall not be a ground for rejection.”
 35. Payment shall be made based on actual measurements recorded at site and verified by Engineer-in-Charge. BOQ quantities are indicative and payment shall be made for actual executed quantities
 36. If the work is not completed within the stipulated period of 15 days, penalty @2% per week of the awarded cost shall be deducted from the Contractor’s Bill for each extra week or part thereof taken to complete the work, subject to a maximum of 10% of the awarded cost. RGNAU shall be at liberty to complete the work at the risk and cost of contractor due to delay of more than 2 weeks.
 37. The successful bidder shall submit Performance Security equal to 5% of the awarded value in the form of Bank Guarantee or FDR from a Scheduled Commercial Bank within 5 days of issue of Work Award Letter. The same shall be valid up to the Defect Liability Period plus 60 days
 38. Defect Liability Period shall be 12 months from the date of issue of Completion Certificate.
 39. Contractors enlisted with CPWD/PWD/MES/Railways or any other Government Department/PSU, as well as other eligible agencies having adequate technical capability and resources to execute the work, are eligible to participate in the tender.
 40. Rate quoted by the vendor should be all inclusive (Taxes and other charges).
 41. The bidder is advised to visit and inspect the site at their own cost and obtain all necessary information regarding site conditions, access, and other factors affecting execution of the work. It shall be deemed that the bidder has fully acquainted themselves with the site conditions, and no claim on this account shall be entertained after submission of the bid.
